

# HOSPITALITY TEAM

Dear member of the HOSPITALITY Team,

We deeply **thank you** for deciding to get involved in this wonderful service of welcoming.

The Greek word translated “hospitality” is *philoxenia*. It is made up of two words that literally translated would mean “love of strangers.” Hospitality is expressing **love to strangers**.

Our team is a big key for our church : allow each and every one, occasional visitor or regular member, to **feel like home**. This is especially important because our church welcomes people from all over the world, and they may sometimes feel strangers in our country.

## 1. ENVIRONMENT (SET UP) : Create a welcoming place

- Set up signs, chairs, tables, infos, coffee, toilets

## 2. GREETING : Warmly welcome visitors and regular members

Wear your **badge** (stored in the translation box, with necklace, choose your color)

**2 people** at the door to :

- Welcome
- Help with seating
- Help with translation set

For newcomers :

- Try to get their name
- Show them the e-bulletin sign-up sheet and the lifegroup panel

At the end of the service :

- Try to get in touch with newcomers and lonely people

### 3. CLEAN UP

- Pick-up signs, chairs, tables, infos, coffee, toilets

  - + 25 old chairs to bring downstairs and 15 upstairs

End	Get in touch with newcomers and lonely people
End	Pick-up chairs, tables, infos, signs, toilets
